

## **Bowling Green defeats Dayton**

BOWLING GREEN, Ohio (AP) — Sophomore running back Dave Preston scored five touchdowns, tying a Mid-American Conference football record, as Bowling Green exploded in the second half and beat Dayton 41-21 Saturday.

After the Falcons went into the second half trailing 21-7, Preston scored twice in a 13-second span.

Preston scored on a seven-yard run with 10:34 left in the third period, then plunged one yard for another touchdown, after his teammates had recovered the Falcons' kickoff on the one-yard line. The two TDs cut the Flyers lead to 21-19.

The 5-foot-11, 192-pounder put the Falcons ahead with a two-yard run in the final period, then added two touchdowns on runs of 15 and nine yards.

The five touchdowns matched the record set by Joe Schwartz of Toledo in 1971 and Jack Mancos of Kent State in 1951.

The victory was Bowling Green's first in two games. Dayton now is 2-1
