

Nov. 4 - Bowling Green 33, Ohio 7

The Falcons broke a four-game losing streak with an impressive 33-7 win over Ohio at Perry Stadium.

Bowling Green opened the scoring at the 5:30 mark of the first quarter as Keylan Cates capped a seven-play, 70-yard drive with a one-yard run. Ohio came right back on their next possession to score on a 15-yard pass play to even the score.

But, BG answered the Bobcats score with a 13-yard Cates run at the 14:54 mark of the second stanza to take the lead for good. His run ended an eight-play, 65-yard drive. Derek Schorejs kicked a 25-yard field goal at the 8:28 mark of the second quarter and added a 40-yarder at 7:12 of the third quarter, which capped a 16-play, 59-yard drive.

Quarterback Bob Niemet hooked up with Jacque Rogers from six yards out at 14:54 of the fourth quarter and Cates closed the scoring at the 5:55 mark of the final quarter with his third touchdown on a one-yard run.

BG ended the game with a 428-173 edge in total offense and a 38:58 to 21:02 edge in time of possession. BG possessed the ball for 22:30 of the second half as the OU offense ran just 13 plays netting 23 yards.

Cates carried 43 times for 180 yards in the game while Niemet had the best day of his young career completing 17-of-25 passes for 233 yards and one score.
