

Nov. 1 - at Kent 29, Bowling Green 20

Bowling Green dropped its four consecutive game losing for only the second time in the last 24 meetings with Kent as the Golden Flashes scored a pair of second-half touchdowns which were the difference in a 29-20 victory.

The two teams traded two touchdowns in the first quarter, two Kent scores on passes sandwiched in between a Bowling Green fumble return for a score and a Robbie Hollis 28-yard run.

After the two teams traded field goals in the second frame, the Falcons took a 17-16 lead to the locker room.

But, Kent took the lead for good on a 24-yard pass play at the 4:16 mark of the third quarter, and after a Bowling Green field goal with 29 seconds left in the third, Kent iced the game on the third Jose Davis to Eugene Baker connection with 11:48 left in the contest.

Bowling Green drove into Kent territory with both its final drives, but could not come up with any points on either possession.

Kent, second in the MAC in total offense averaging 447.1 yards per game, had 482 yards ot 361 for the Falcons who were whistled for a school-record 14 penalties for 135 yards. Kent had averaged just under 40 points per game in its last five contests. Kent registered five sacks in the contest.
