

Oct. 24 - at Bowling Green 42, Kent 21

The Falcons rode a strong running attack to win its 23rd meeting in its last 25 games against Kent earning a 42-21 decision at Perry Stadium.

After Kent opened the scoring on a 20-yard pass play midway through the first quarter, the Falcons would score 35 unanswered points before the Golden Flashes would find paydirt again.

All six of BG's scores came on the ground as they rang up 424 yards rushing. Senior Adam Lige and freshman John Gibson had a pair of scoring runs while junior Steve Holmes and senior Bob Niemet each had one. Holmes' 17-yard run for six points put the Falcons ahead for good at the 17 second mark of the first stanza.

Holmes had 11 carries of eight or more yards in the game on his way to 220 yards on 27 carries. It was the second-highest figure in school history. His day included a 60-yard run which set up BG's first score of the second half, the second-longest non-scoring run in school history.

Lige set career highs for carries (18) and yards (70) as did Gibson (57 yards on eight carries) and junior Brett Martin (53 yards on 10 carries). BG had 23 rushing first downs to equal the school record on its way to 502 yards of total offense.
