

Oct. 23 - at Ohio 17, Bowling Green 14

The Falcons lost their third straight in a game of two halves.

Ohio won the first half rolling up all 17 of their points and owning a 197-48 edge in total offense. The Falcons managed just 25 plays in the opening 30 minutes as the Bobcats controlled the clock possessing the ball for 17:25.

BG owned the second half scoring all its points in a 4:35 span late in the third quarter and early in the fourth stanza. The Falcons had a 203-102 edge in total offense in the second half as both teams ran 33 plays.

After a Joe Alls 59-yard scamper got the Falcons within three points at 17-14, BG had three more possessions in the game but could not get into Ohio territory on any of the three drives.

BG was in Ohio territory just one other time in the game except for the two scoring drives, and that early third quarter drive ended at the Ohio 43-yard line.
